The Town Board of the Town of Pembine, Marinette County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

A public hearing to discuss a proposed action to discontinue a public way in the Town of Pembine shall be held as provided in accordance with the following Notice of Hearing.

The town clerk shall publish the following Notice of Hearing as a class 3 notice under ch. 985, Wis. stats., and the town clerk shall cause the Notice of Hearing to be served on the owners of all of the frontage of lots and lands abutting upon the public way sought to be discontinued in the manner provided for the service of summons in circuit court at least 30 days before the hearing, except that when service cannot be made within the town, a copy of the notice shall be mailed to the owner's last-known address at least 30 days before the hearing:

NOTICE OF HEARING – DISCONTINUANCE OF A PUBLIC WAY IN THE TOWN OF PEMBINE,

A public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Pembine at the Town Hall on October 21, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.,* to discuss a proposed action to commence discontinuance of the following described town road initiated by introduction of resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Pembine under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. stats.,] specifically: Lake Lane.

The discontinuance of the above-described public way will not result in a land locked property and no owner of property abutting the discontinued public way will be damaged by the discontinuance. The discontinued town road will be vacated and the land awarded to the following owner or owners of real estate abutting the discontinued road: Lake Lundgren Bible Camp Incorporated.


The town clerk shall file in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Marinette County, Wisconsin, a lis pendens related to the proposed discontinuance of public way.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
